- Dialogue delivery competition with costumes. For middle and high school on 18/9/24.



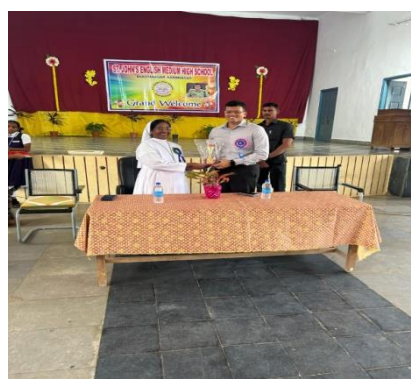
VII. Training Programmes/seminars /workshops attended:

VIII. Celebrations:

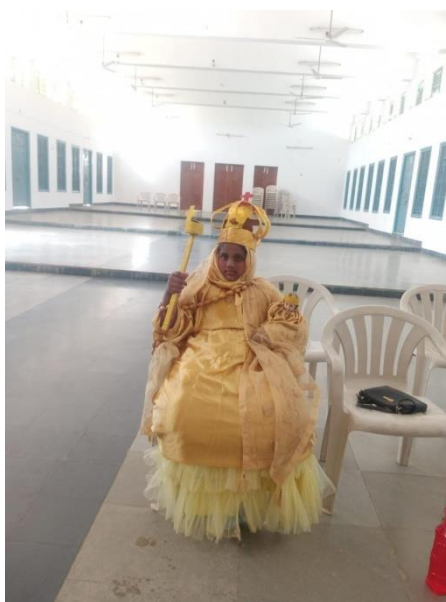
